*Hi Ralph,*

*Just wanted to let you know that the planned change over for WWHO-TV to ATSC 3.0 (the reason for the re-scan for WSYX/WTTE) has been moved back from December 3rd to January 7th (10:00 am). The reason for the re-scan is the ATSC 1.0 signal for WWHO will now be carried on WSYX and WTTE sub channels. Anyone who might happen to have an ATSC 3.0 receiver will be able to get the new signal starting January 7 (barring any other unforeseen delays) and it will include WWHO, WSYX, WTTE and at some point WCMH all from the same transmitter.*
